## CHILD PROTECTION INCIDENT REPORTING PROCEDURE - Responding to signs/allegation of abuse A child shows signs of abuse or an incident is reported Remember: be calm, reassure the child. Be honest, do not make promises you can't keep. Keep questions to a member of staff about abuse to a minimum. Make notes so you can fill out the EH CPIRF. π Remember: it is not your responsibility to decide to investigate if abuse has occurred.
